INTRODUCTION

St. Paul Public School, established in 2007 by St. Paul Educational Society, is a co-education, Semi-Residential school, at Station Road, Teghra, Begusarai (Bihar) India. The school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education New Delhi, for All India Secondary School Examination and All India Senior School Certificate, Examinations. It has classes from Nur to XII. Admissions to the school are based on an entrance examination and interview but for Std Nur & LKG test is exempted. The school is governed by its Board of Governors whose Director is Mr Sunil Kumar Singh and Principal of the school is Mrs. Tanu Saurav MA, B.Ed, M.Ed. The Campus is spread over an area of 3 acres that holds serene beauty and surroundings near NH.-28. More than 3 acres are occupied by the school complex consisting of a four - storeyed, academic block, science laboratories, workshops, hobby centres, library and art block, boarding house,

AIM AND OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHOOL

ADMISSION

1. For admission in Nursery & L.K.G. test is not required
2. Admission in above classes will be strictly on merit basis
3. Minimum age for admission in Nursery is 3 years
4. The date of admission test is specified on the registration form
5. The names of the selected candidates will be displayed on the Notice Board
6. Five days time will be given for admission after displaying the result on the Notice Board
7. Fee is to be deposited at the time of admission
8. Preference is given to the candidates having good background in music, dance, debate, dramatics, games & Sports, etc.

REGISTRATION

The School session starts from 1st week of April every year and ends during the third week of March. The first step towards admission is registration. After registration, a mutually convenient date is fixed for an entrance test and interview of the child. Admissions are based on the performance of the child, the entrance test and availability of seats in the particular class/hostel. The School takes admission from Class Nur to XI.

ENTRANCE TEST

After Registration the School will get back to the parents to fix a mutually convenient date for the entrance test/ interview. Please note that registration does not guarantee admission. The admission test is designed so as to check the academic proficiency of the child based on the CBSE syllabus of the class in which the child is studying. It is a general test and is conducted in the subjects English, Maths, Hindi and General Awareness. One does not need to specially prepare for the test.

ADMISSION TO CLASS XI

The session for Class XI starts in the mid April every year. As the results of Class X are declared by CBSE admission to Class XI is offered on the basis of the Pre-board performance of the child in Class X and the final report of Class IX. The School offers Science and Commerce streams. All admissions to Class XI are provisional till CBSE results are declared. The provisional admission shall be confirmed on performance basis of the child in his / her board examination.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

School life would be monotonous without entertainment. But, crude entertainment leads to erode the value system and personality of the students. We train students and conduct various activities like Music, Dramatics, Debate, Quiz and Extempore etc to provide them with best possible exposure at different levels. Students debate on burning topics in the Assembly and leave the audience with a food for thought.

Inter - House and Intra class literary competitions are held sticking to academic calendar where every student gets an opportunity to take part in at least any two such activities.

The School Band and the choir is the pride of the school. It consists of some of the rarest talents. We have vocalists, drummers and synthesizers of repute.

Inter-House Drama competition is one of the most eagerly awaited event for all Stpaulians. The House provides ample opportunities to display acting skills.

ACADEMICS

Education is a continuous process and so is the evaluation of academic and Co-curricular performance. The child's performance is evaluated not only at the end of semester but throughout based on their day-to-day work/ activities/projects/ assignments etc. and subject wise effort grades are awarded in all areas of involvement at the end of the term with detailed report on scholastic and non-scholastic achievement of the children.

The performance of students from Class Nur. to VIII are evaluated based on their class room activities/participation in discussion/ assignment/ individual projects, practicals etc. and periodical tests/exams so that they may be well prepared to face the challenges of the Board examinations at the end.

For class IX-X, and XI-XII Board's evaluation guidelines will be strictly followed.

Annual promotion to the students will not be given only on the basis of Annual Examination alone but on the basis of their entire year's performance.
